Application



 Remove first liner and anchor the adhesive side of the dressing to the skin



Place the narrow end a minimum of 2cm (¾in.) above the anal sphincter, then smooth the dressing over the sacrum



- Remove remaining liners
- Smooth over
- If on a wound, ensure absorbent pad covers the wound
- Do not stretch the dressing



- Smooth the borders, ensuring no creases that could compromise the seal
- The dressing can be
 repositioned as required

Observation

When used for pressure ulcer prevention, frequently inspect the skin for pressure damage by lifting back one corner, inspecting and then repositioning the dressing.

Removal

Lift the top edge and slowly peel downwards towards the anus until completely removed. This will minimize the chance of transmitting infection.


Frequency of change

During the early stages of treatment inspect the dressing frequently. Sacral dressings can be left in place for up to 5 days. Dressings should be changed depending on the condition of the wound and surrounding skin or when exudate covers

75% of the change indicator.

Consider changing if the exudate covers more than 50% of the change indicator.

The diagram below is for guidance only and the decision of when to change should be dependent upon clinical assessment and local protocols under the guidance of a Healthcare Professional.
