# Implant Card training: Un-boxing, delivery methods, and patient leaflet

#### What is the Implant Card?

The Implant Card is required by the EU/ANZ to be shipped with the device and given to the patient. The Implant Card contains device specific information with a link to the eIFU website for patients to obtain the Implant Leaflet and view additional device information.

### Un-boxing the Implant Card

Un-box the Implant device and retrieve the Chartstik labels. The Implant Cards are labels and appear as the first two labels




Note: If no Implant Card is available, please use the Chartstik label

**DO NOT** discard the Implant Cards or the Chartstik labels



Health care Provider (HCP) must save the Implant Cards and Chartstik labels in the patient folder

### Delivery Methods

#### What are the Implant Card delivery methods?

The Implant Card delivery methods are comprised of two (2) printed pieces, an accordion folder and a sleeve. The accordion can hold up to 7 Implant Cards and the sleeve is the protective pouch for the accordion.



Note: these delivery steps are not mandatory, however, HCP needs to ensure the Patient is provided the Implant Card/ Charstik label.



HCP adheres the Implant Card/Chartstik labels to the accordion folder



Note up to 7 Implant Cards will fit on the accordion folder

HCP fills in the Patient, Surgery Information, and Manufacturer name and address on the folder



Place the accordion folder into the S+N Implant Card Sleeve

HCP provides the Implant Card(s)/Chartstik labels in the sleeve to the patient



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




#### Patient leaflet
