Who is eligible to save?*

If you've been prescribed REGRANEX° (becaplermin) gel, 0.01% and pay more than \$25 out of pocket for your prescription, and are commercially insured, you may be eligible to save. Participants in governmental healthcare programs or where copay assistance is taxed, restricted, or otherwise prohibited by law are not eligible.

Just how much will I save?

Eligible recipients will pay the first \$25; Smith & Nephew will pay the remaining out-of-pocket cost up to the next \$200.*

What is REGRANEX Gel?

REGRANEX gel is a protein medicine made in yeast that is used with other ulcer care practices (such as good wound care) to treat diabetic sores (ulcers) of your legs or feet that are deeper than just your skin, in people who have good blood supply to the legs.

It is not known if REGRANEX gel is effective for the treatment of pressure ulcers or ulcers that are due to poor blood flow (circulation). It is not known if REGRANEX gel is safe and effective in children under 16 years of age.

Important Safety Information

REGRANEX (becaplermin) gel 0.01% is indicated for treating lower extremity diabetic ulcers that extend under the skin and have adequate blood supply. The effectiveness of REGRANEX gel has not been established in pressure ulcers, or venous ulcers. REGRANEX gel is not substitute for good ulcer care practices. REGRANEX gel is contraindicated for patients with a tumor at the site(s) of application. REGRANEX gel is non-sterile so it should not be used in wounds that heal without tissue loss (primary intention). Side effects include rashes, burning sensation, and redness at the site of application. Tumors distant from the site of application have been reported in both a clinical study and in real world use.
