

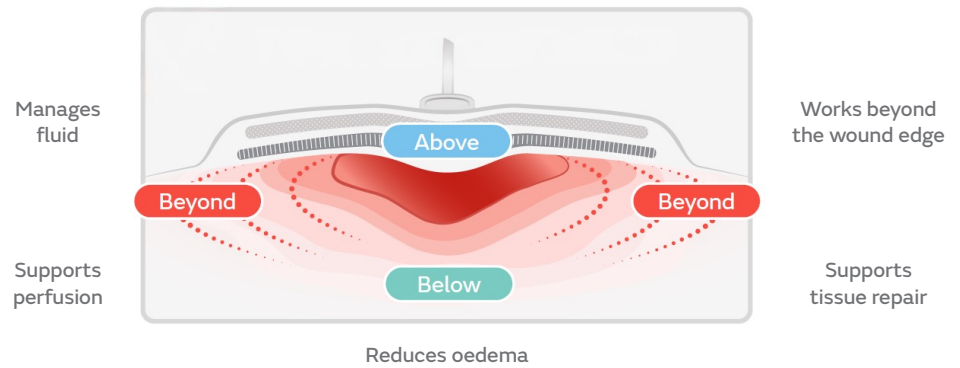

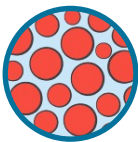


How PICO^o sNPWT supports healing

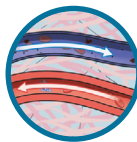
PICO 360° proactive therapy mode of action applies consistent negative pressure above, beyond, and below the wound.



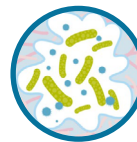
What happens in the tissue



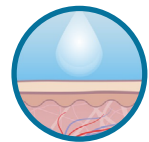
Supports cell migration and proliferation

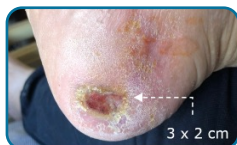

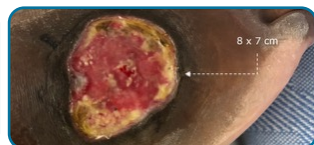
Real world insights

Rapid size reduction observed in previously stalled wounds.
Healing progression continues beyond therapy phase.

Real-world outcomes: German wound audit

- Most wounds were stagnant or slow-healing before PICO sNPWT
- After introducing PICO sNPWT:
 - 48% healed completely
 - 48% reduced in size
 - Only 1 wound showed no response

Clear improvement in healing progression after introducing PICO sNPWT.

20,000-patient UK dataset

- Nearly half of wounds are non-healing
- 8 in 10 patients are aged 65+
- Outcomes are influenced by patient complexity and system-level factors

Non-healing wounds are common, and require a proactive, system-wide approach.

How to apply in practice



- IF** progressing → Continue pathway
- IF NOT** progressing → Reassess environment → Consider therapy beyond the surface
- DURING** treatment → Monitor and adapt early

When a wound fails to progress, don't just treat the wound; treat the environment around it

Get non-healing wounds back on track
