Scalp wound s/p basal cell carcinoma removal

Case study

60-year-old male with diabetes treated with MOHs Surgery for BCC presented at 6 days with 16 cm x 5 cm x 0.5 cm wound.

Procedure

- Scalp debridement and STRAVIX Tissue applied as a cover, sutured in place. Wound covered with Low-Adherent Surgical Dressing and NPWT for first 2 weeks
- At one-month, split thickness skin graft applied and another week of NPWT.









Scalp reconstruction with STRAVIX Meshed Tissue Case study

82-year-old male with A fib, hypertension, history of multiple skin cancers and renal cancer presented with melanoma.

Procedure

- Vertex of scalp resected down to the skull, wound measured 8 cm x 8 cm x 0.75 cm. Wide local excision of lesion with sentinel lymph node biopsy
- STRAVIX Meshed Tissue sewn into wound. Nonadherent dressing and NPWT applied over graft for 13-days.
